“IF TIME ALLOWS” discussion activity

BE CAREFUL... Do not give your opinion, and let the student's discuss. Please just stimulate discussion!

*****PLEASE READ FIRST*****

The basis for this activity is discussion with relevancy to faith! This activity is not meant to draw students into action. It is through discussion that we learn.

What is dignity?

In the first 10 months on Washington State's assisted suicide law... which is ironically called the "Death with Dignity" law 36 people have opted for the use of assisted suicide.

In Washington State any resident of Washington who is at least 18, is mentally competent and has been diagnosed with a terminal illness that gives them six months or less to live can ask to be given a lethal dose of medication by a doctor.

The Catholic Catechism states:

2282 Voluntary co-operation in suicide is contrary to the moral law.

If our right to life is a gift from God, how can a law that allows the premature end life be called the death with dignity. Is it undignified to let death take its natural course?

What is the student's definition of Dignity?

Societies and culture define dignity in a particular way. How does OUR culture define dignity as it relates to different people...

- Women
- Workers
- Children
- Family
- Terminally ill patients

Do we as a society treat people with dignity? If yes... how? If no... how?
