The guidelines are:

- Service must be completed for a nonprofit organization
- Students must complete the required number of hours of service; it can be completed as a class or individually. Class service outings must be organized by the catechist
- There needs to be a connection between who we are as Christians and the motives behind the service
- The candidates need to be able to complete a service journal entry for each service site answering the following questions:
  - What is the connection between who we are as Christians and the motives behind the service?
  - How did the act of service make you feel?
  - What immediate results did you observe after the completion of your service?
  - What did you learn from the experience?
  - How can this service experience make you a better Christian?
  - How did your service make the world a better place?
- At the completion of the service, all candidates will need to get a signature and phone number from the supervisor at the service site.
- **Service must be completed by the first session in April.**
